The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children, 3 –12 years of age, based on the conviction that God and the child are in relationship. Inspired by Montessori methodology, this approach had its start in 1954 when Sofia Cavalletti, a scripture scholar, and Gianni Gobbi, a Montessori educator, founded the Good Shepherd Atrium in Rome
