## Atrium Preparation Check List

- Touch base with catechist about this week's lesson and other plans
- Prepare your heart and mind with quiet and a prayerful attitude.
- Catechists and assistants may want to begin their time with a short prayer of thanks for the children and this work, offering the children and the time to God.
- Is the atrium ready for the children to enter?
- Help children enter the atrium in an orderly way. The children should greet the catechist by shaking his/ her hand at the door.
